Many of you have asked how things have been going with the copper banding. I am happy to report that it should be completed either the end of July or the first couple of days in August. I have asked Sterling Commercial Roofing about all the marks/hand prints on the copper. They will not be polished because that will cause uneven weathering. The



manufacturer suggests to leave it, and the markings will not be visible once patina begins to form in a couple of months.

Inside the building, we are taking the time to paint the stacks walls and ceiling. This will be completed by the second week in August.
