Sterling Public Library Summer Reading Programs

The Sterling Public Library will be offering a virtual summer reading program for children. We are using the READsquared again this year and have made some modifications to make it more user friendly.

Registration for 2021 summer reading for Children "STEM and Stories" begins May 1, 2021. Online programs begin Monday, June 7, 2021. Go to the library webpage, <u>sterlingpubliclibrary.org</u>, hover over the Program Calendar button on the information bar and you will be directed to the information you need to register your children.

In addition to the READsquared program Miss Mary will be doing weekly online programs beginning June 7, 2021. Once you have registered and insert your email address you will receive a weekly email to gain access to the programs. Program schedule is as follows:

Preschool Programs are at 10:00 AM on Mondays-June 7, 14, 21, 28 and Monday, July 5, 12 and 19

K-2 Programs are at 10:00 AM on Wednesdays-June 9, 16, 23, 30 and Wednesday, July 7, July 14 and 21

Grade 3-5 Programs are at 1:00 PM on Wednesdays-June 9, 16, 23, 30 and Wednesday July 7, July 14 and 21

Activity packets will be available for the June and July programs. They will be available beginning May 24, 2021 at the Children's Circulation desk at the library. Your child must be registered in order to receive a packet. There are different packets for each age group.

Teen and Adult Summer Reading Challenge

There is also a summer reading challenge for teens and adults called "Reading Colors Your World" that runs June 7, 2021 through July 25, 2021. Inquire at the Adult Circulation for information regarding these two programs.
