





### Director's Corner

The Library is officially fine free for all Sterling Library patrons beginning May 1<sup>st</sup>. This means we will not be charging overdue fees on materials. (Not including GoGo Gadgets) Thank you, Library Board of Directors, for approving this new policy! If you or somebody you know hasn't come into the library because they have overdue fines, you can stop worrying. Just return the materials and all material fines will be waived.

The new policy does state that patrons will continue to pay for lost or damaged material. Material will be considered lost by the system 28 days after the due date at which time the staff may decide to replace the item due to popularity. If the item has been repurchased, the patron will then need to pay for the item regardless if they return the item or not. The Library Board also approved waiving all fines on lost materials prior to 2020.

The library has two book drops for patrons to return their material. One book drop is located on the south side of the building next to the main entrance and the other is located on the east side of the building near the parking lot.
